Research Study of Childhood Vaccination with H1N1 Vaccine

Principal Investigator - Dr. David Connor

What is the purpose?

- We are trying to learn more about a new vaccine that may help prevent people from getting sick with the H1N1 flu.

Who is participating?

- Children who are 6 months to less than 9 years of age who are in general good health. Participants will be attending six visits from September 2009 to October 2010.

What is involved?

- Children will receive two vaccinations, with follow-up testing including blood work and questionnaires for parents via phone and diary cards.

This study will examine which dose of H1N1 vaccine is most effective. All children in the study will receive a vaccine; however they will be randomly put into 1 of 4 groups. Each group will have a different dose of vaccine. Staff and parents will not know which dose the child receives.
